



Spring Start-Up:

Step 1: Close all water spigots. There is usually one inside by the water shut-off and two outside by the manifold.

Step 2: Slowly open the water shut-off (***handle is now parallel with pipe***). This is usually in the basement by the water meter (remember to do it slowly).

Step 3: Check your manifold for leaks and run each zone to check for leaks and broken heads. If you find damage, please give us a call at **701-400-1117** and we can service your system to repair any damage.

Fall Shut Down:

In order to prevent damage to your irrigation system, contact our Certified Technicians at **701-400-1117** to winterize underground pipes and drain the backflow preventer.

Step 1: Slowly close the water shut-off (***handle is now perpendicular with pipe***). This is usually in the basement by the water meter (remember to do it slowly).

Step 2: Open and drain all water spigots. There is usually one inside by the water shut-off and two outside by the zone valves.

Step 3: Close water spigot inside until we winterize and drain your outdoor pipes. Once your winterization is complete, the indoor spigot should be reopened until springtime.
